SHERIFF'S REPORT: Wade says he's making some personal changes. Some towns in the county are complaining they're not getting enough patrol time from the deputies. He says deputies wages with car, fuel, insurance, ect. run about \$60.00 per hour. For deputies patrolling Arthur for 1.5 hrs a day cost the city of Arthur \$92.86 per day.

REPORT: MAINTENANCE Anderson and Arbegast drug the infield at the ballfield, replaced all four bases. Replaced burnt out light bulbs on the ball field. Picked up four ton of red ball clav/sand at Breda to put on the infield and the batting cage. Sprayed and back drug the weeds out of the batting. Planted 5 Techney Arborvitae trees in the city park. Burned the dump and cleaned it up. Took the chains and snowplow off the truck and dumped out the road gravel. Changed oil and put a new drain plug on the lawn mower also cleaned the battery post and charged the battery. Cleaned up snowplow messes around town.
