

PUBLIC NOTICE: STORM WATER DISCHARGE

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The City of Danbury plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit Number 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities" for public construction in Danbury, Iowa.

The stormwater discharge will be from site grading associated with the wastewater improvements. Soil disturbing activities will include the following: excavation, utility installation, lagoon grading, building and other miscellaneous construction, and the preparation for final planting and seeding. The project is located just outside the city limits of Danbury, Iowa and more specifically within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 Township 86 North, Range 42 West and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27

Township 86 North, Range 42 West of Woodbury County, Iowa.

Runoff is currently collected in on-site basins before draining off-site. Runoff will drain off-site to the southeast via one point source and to the south via one non-point source. The proposed site will sheet flow with a small swale on the east side of the site which travels underneath the existing gravel drive and ultimately drains into the Maple River.
