311 Barnes Street 1. Call to Order: Mayor, Nathan Weitl, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. 2. Roll Call: Present: Gregor Ernst, Jeff Miesner & Ange Johnson. Jared Bogue and Jason Schable were absent at this time. Attorney, Ryan Gaskins, was pres-ent. 3. Approval of Agenda: Motion by Miesner, second by Ernst to approve. Motion carried 3-0. 4. Corey Trucke - Ida County EMS: Corey Trucke and Devlun Whiteing provided a preliminary draft of the desired EMS building. They reported the EMS Board met and are looking for a location that is centrally located within the county and a great interest in Highway 175 through Ida Grove. Sweeden provided an update on discussions held with representatives from lowa DNR in regards to the Robin Hill Trust property located at 602 Highway 175. Discussion will continue as more information is received. 5. Family of Robert (Kathryn) Spotts - City Council Chambers Memorial Donation: Jared Bogue arrived at this time, 5:52 p.m. The following family members of the late Robert Spotts were present: wife, Kathryn Spotts and daughters; Teresa Lansink, Julie Mauer, Janna Thompson & Stacey Ernst. Lansink stated Ida Grove has been called home to their family for many generations. Community involvement is very important to Robert and Kathryn as Robert served on the City Council from 1972-1979 and Kathryn assisted in many elections. The Spotts family is here tonight to present a donation in the amount of \$25,000 in honor of Robert and Kathryn that will fund the furnishings of the newly constructed City Council Chambers. The chambers will be finished including a plaque in honor of Robert and Kathryn. 6. Ethan Joy - Maguire Iron Change Order #4, Interior Water Tower Painting \$131,000: A formal change order for repainting the interior of the water tower tank was presented. Motion by Miesner, second by Ernst to approve. Motion carried 4-0. 7. Ida Grove Economic De-

velopment Corporation - Splash Pad: Owen Bolte, President of Ida Grove Economic Development, presented preliminary drawings prepared by a creative firm from Des Moines, Confluence, which were a result of a visioning session that was recently held at City Park. Phase 1 of the plans include development of a splash pad west of the current basketball courts. Ida Grove Economic Development is working in partnership with Ida Grove Ki-wanis on fundraising efforts for the project. The annual Kiwanis Ball is this weekend, and they have gra-ciously committed to donating half of the funds raised to the splash pad project. Some additional future goals from the visioning session include connecting the pleasant valley trail to the park, addition of a walking loop around the City a bandshell. TOOC truck plaza, upgraded restrooms and ADA accessible playground, to name a few. Bolte noted they're not requesting funding from the City for the splash pad project, but upon completion any future maintenance and upkeep costs would be City responsibility. Bolte asked if there is council support of the project to report back to his group. Council all agreed they're supportive and re-quested Sweeden to prepare a formal resolution stating such. 8. Council reviewed the application requesting zoning amendment from suburban to general commercial. Sweeden noted the application is complete, including the required amount of signatures from properties within a 250 ft. radius and filing
