If the IUB grants the right for condemnation, Summit may petition the Chief Judge of the Judicial District for Ida County to appoint a compensation The commission. compensation sets the compensation commission amounts. Summit may then proceed with the work to construct, operate, and maintain the Pipeline. The landowner or Summit may appeal the amount determined by the compensation commission to the courts

The IUB has established 10 a.m. on Aug 22, 2023, as the time to begin the public hearing on Summit's petition. The hearing will be held at Cardiff Event Center, 3232 First Avenue South, Fort Dodge, Iowa
