BY AMENDING CHAPTER 13.05 WATER SERVICE**
BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Ida Grove, Iowa,
A new Chapter 13.05.251 is added as follows:
13.05.251. RATES FOR BULK WATER.
Water may be furnished by the City and transported in a water tank
furnished by the customer. Bulk water will be billed as follows:
Meter hook-up fee: \$40.00
Per day fee: \$5.00
Water usage measured by the meter will be billed according to the
current rates under 13.05.250.
REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the
provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this
ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication
shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section,
provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval
and publication as provided by law.

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 616
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDA GROVE
REGARDING CITY ELECTIONS**
BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Ida Grove, Iowa.
Section 1.
To replace Chapter 2.10, the following is adopted:
2.10.010 NOMINATING METHOD TO BE USED. All candidates for
elective municipal offices shall be nominated under the provisions of
Chapter 45 of the Code of Iowa.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 376.3)
2.10.020 NOMINATIONS BY PETITION. Nominations for elective
municipal offices of the City may be made by nomination paper or
papers signed by not less than ten (10) eligible electors, residents of
the City.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 45.1)
2.10.030 ADDING NAME BY PETITION. The name of a candidate
placed upon the ballot by any other method than by petition shall not be
added by petition for the same office.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 45.2)
2.10.040 PREPARATION OF PETITION AND AFFIDAVIT. Nomination
papers shall include a petition and an affidavit of candidacy. The petition
and affidavit shall be in substantially the form prescribed by the State
Commissioner of Elections, shall include information required by the
Code of Iowa, and shall be signed in accordance with the Code of Iowa.
*(Code of Iowa, Sec. 45.3,
45.5 & 45.6)*
2.10.050 FILING, PRESUMPTION, WITHDRAWALS, OBJECTIONS.
The time and place of filing nomination petitions, the presumption of
validity thereof, the right of a candidate so nominated to withdraw and the
effect of such withdrawal, and the right to object to the legal sufficiency
of such petitions, or to the eligibility of the candidate, shall be governed
by the appropriate provisions of Chapter 44 of the Code of Iowa.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 45.4)
2.10.060 PERSONS ELECTED. The candidates who receive the
greatest number of votes for each office on the ballot are elected, to the
extent necessary to fill the positions open.
(Code of Iowa, Sec. 376.8[3])

Section 2.
When Effective. This ordinance will be in effect after its final passage and
approval and publication as provided by law.
Section 3.
If any portion of this ordinance is determined to be invalid, such
determination will not affect the remainder of the ordinance.
