1. Call to Order: Mayor, Devlun Whiteing, called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

2. Roll Call: Present: Gregor Ernst, Jason Schable, Jared Bogue, Ange Johnson.

3. Approval of Agenda: Motion by Bogue to approve, second by Johnson. Motion carried 4-0.

4. Consent Agenda: Miesner arrived at 6:01 p.m. Motion by Ernst to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following: clerk's report, claims in the amount of \$172,746.12, financials, minutes of the 10/3/2022 meeting, permits and correspondence, second by Bogue. Motion carried 5-0.

5. Ordinance 611 - Council Meeting Time, 1st Reading: Motion by Miesner to approve the first reading of Ordinance 611 (changing council meeting start time to 5:30 p.m.), second by Ernst. Motion carried 5-0.

6. Resolution 2022-49 - Approving New Employee Salaries: Motion by Ernst to approve Resolution 2022-49, pending satisfactory completion of pre-employment screenings,

second by Bogue. Motion carried 5-0.

7. Resolution 2022-50 Setting Bid Dates and Directing Advertisement for the Ida Grove Downtown Facade Project: Motion by Bogue to approve Resolution 2022-50, second by Miesner. Motion carried 5-0.

8. DOT 2023 Crack Sealing: The IADOT informed the City they will be completing crack sealing along Highway 175 in 2023. Bid letting is currently slated for January of 2023.

9. City Hall Construction Bidding: Council directed the following changes be made to the bidding requirements: remove the early deadline for retaining wall completion, extend the project completion date to March 1, 2024 and request Glen-Gery Stonington Gray as the primary brick color choice.

10. City Council Member News & Notes: Property nuisances and trucks not following the truck route were discussed.

11. Adjournment: Motion by Johnson to adjourn, second by Bogue. Motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
