**City of Ida Grove
Special Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, Feb. 23, 2026 • 5 p.m.
City Hall, 403 3rd Street**

Call to Order: Mayor, Nathan Weitl, called the meeting to order at 5 p.m. **Roll Call:** Council members present: Jeff Miesner, Jason Schable, Jason Behrendsen, Gregor Ernst & Jared Bogue joined remotely for a portion of the meeting. Library Board President Jackie Netherton, Library Director Angela Scales and City Clerk Heather Sweeden were also present. **Approval of Agenda:** Motion by Miesner, second by Schable to approve. Motion carried 4-0. **FY27 Budget Workshop:** Council heard from Netherton and Scales regarding the Library budget request, noting no major changes. The total Library budget request is \$126,889 with Scales anticipating revenue in the amount of \$25,262 and the City contribution being the difference of expense and revenue in the amount of \$101,607. There were no major changes to the flood control, parks, and streets operating budgets, but there are several requests for updated equipment such as mowers and a street sweeper. Bogue arrived at this time 5:49 p.m.

Council also discussed needed street repairs. **Main Street Bridge Fencing:** The current plans call for black vinyl chain link fence, however, after discussion council agreed solid concrete and black metal railing similar to the 5th & 7th Street bridges is preferred. Sweeden will contact the engineer to request an addendum to the plans. Bid letting is set for March 17. **City Intent to Allow Wallace Construction to Remove Concrete from City Property Free of Charge:** City Hall was contacted by a local contractor requesting to remove the concrete on City property at Elm and Maple Street, free of charge. The topic will be on the next regular meeting agenda for decision. If anyone objects, they should appear at the Monday, March 2, 2026 meeting. **408 Second Street - Building Contents:** Council discussed the building contents and will determine at a future meeting whether to sell or recycle the large appliances and restaurant equipment. **Ida County Community Betterment Foundation Grant:** Council agreed for the City to apply for six solar powered charging stations to be located at various locations. Bogue left the meeting, 6:29 p.m. The Historical Society requested City Fiscal Sponsorship on behalf of their grant application for roof replacement at the Stagecoach Inn. Motion by Ernst, second by Miesner to approve the City as the fiscal sponsor for the Historical Society's application to the Ida County Community Betterment Foundation. Motion carried 4-0. **Recommendation on New Hire For Deputy Clerk:** Weitl reviewed the interview process taken for filling the future vacant position of Deputy Clerk, recommending promoting from within to offer the position to current Administrative Assistant, Tonya Rehse. Motion by Miesner, second by Schable to approve hiring Tonya Rehse as Deputy Clerk upon the position becoming vacant. Motion carried 4-0. **Other Business:** Schable shared information regarding Carroll's Rec Center and basketball tournaments, hoping Ida Grove could do something similar in the future. **Adjournment:** Motion by Ernst, second by Miesner to adjourn at 7:11 p.m. Motion carried 4-0.
