"Shall the Ida County Board of Supervisors be authorized to impose an ad valorem property tax for the purpose of creation of maintenance of a stable revenue stream for its essential community EMS services, in the amount of \$0.75 (75 cents) per \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars) of assessed value on all taxable property within the county, to be used for funding of emergen-cy medical services for a maximum period of 15 (fifteen) years?"

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 7th, 2023, on the City/School Election Ballott, Ida County Voters voted 78 percent (78%) in favor of Public Measure E.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that the amount of \$0.75 (75 cents) per \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars) of assessed value on all taxable property within the county, to be used for funding of emergency medical services for a maximum period of 15 (fifteen) years. Effective July 1, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that money collected by this measure shall be held in separate fund and such funds shall be distributed by the Ida County Board of Supervisors based on these described needs and in a manner not inconsistent with Section 422D.6.
