City of Ida Grove Special Council Meeting Minutes Monday, March 23, 2026 • 5 p.m. City Hall, 403 3rd Street Call to Order: Mayor, Nathan Weill, called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m. Roll Call: Council members present: Jeff Miesner, Jason Behrendsen & Jared Bogue. Gregor Ernst & Jason Schable were absent. JEO's Danny Sturm (electronically) & City Clerk Heather Sweeden were also in attendance. Approval of Agenda: Motion by Miesner, second by Bogue to approve. Motion carried 3-0. Danny Sturm, JEO Consulting - Main Street Bridge Construction: Main Street bridge letting took place March 17, 2026 with two bids received as follows: Godbersen Smith Construction Company \$1,347,300.99 and Christensen Bros \$1,448,178.20. The City received a grant from Iowa DOT for construction costs up to \$1.5 million, engineering costs are not eligible for grant reimbursement. Sturm recommended awarding the contract to the low bidder, with construction beginning anytime between contract signing and the late start date of June 15, 2026. Motion by Miesner, second by Behrendsen to award the contract to Godbersen Smith Construction Company. Motion carried 3-0. Sturm presented an engineering contract for construction administration and inspection in an amount not to exceed \$150,000. Motion by Behrendsen, second by Bogue to approve the JEO Construction Services Agreement as presented. Motion carried 3-0. Remove Kelly Young and Add Tonya Rehse as Authorized Signer at United Bank of Iowa and Shelby County State Bank: Motion by Bogue, second by Miesner to approve. Motion carried 3-0. FY27 Budget Workshop: Council thoroughly reviewed the entire FY27 budget, making additional cuts in spending allowances. In review of the water department budget, it was discussed that hiring a 5th public works employee will likely require an additional rate increase. Other Business: None. Adjournment: Motion by Miesner, second by Bogue to adjourn at 6:38 p.m. Motion carried 3-0.
